## How does hunger color dreams of the future?

“ I see stuff on TV that I want to eat. But we need to save our food stamps so they last us all month. My mom says it might be easier if we moved back to the city, but I don't want to leave. Living on the reservation has taught me strength and how to do a lot of things for myself. I think about the future. I think that in the future we'll probably have electricity and water and a better home than we do now. I don't want to drop out of high school or live on food stamps. My dream is to go to college and become a welder. I want to make good money, so I can support myself and give my mom the things she can't buy now. My mom's pushing me to become what I want to become. ”
